BY ROAD:

Visit the College website above to view a route map of Cambridge, showing roads around Queens'. With effect from 2003 August 6, Silver Street has restricted vehicular access at its west end to or from the junction of Queen's Road (the Backs), Sidgwick Avenue, and Newnham Road. The ways to get to or from Queens' are:

- Queens' College has 24-hour two-way access via Trumpington Street and Silver Street from its east end;
- From 06:00 to 10:00, there is access **into** Queens' College **from** the Queen's Road/Sidgwick Avenue junction;
- From 16:00 to 23:59, there is access **out of** Queens' College **to** the Queen's Road/Sidgwick Avenue junction;
- For other times and directions, Silver Street is blocked by rising bollards between Queens' College and Queen's Road.

The recommended route by road to Queens' College is therefore:

- Leave the M11 motorway at Junction 12 and follow the signs for **Cambridge A603**;
- Follow this road, including a forced left-turn at traffic lights (at Grantchester Street) until you reach a roundabout;
 - **From 06:00 to 10:00 only**, go straight across (first exit) into Newnham Road;
 - At traffic lights, turn right into Silver Street and pass through bollards: Queens' College entrances are on the left.
- **At other times**, turn right (second exit) onto Fen Causeway, part of the Ring Road A1134;
- At a mini-roundabout by the Royal Cambridge Hotel, turn left and keep in the left lane;
- Go straight across an immediate second mini-roundabout (at Lensfield Road), to head north up Trumpington Street;
- Go straight past the Mill Lane/Pembroke Street junction;
- At Silver Street, take a forced left turn (King's Parade is closed to motor traffic);
- Follow Silver Street over the River Cam: Queens' College entrances are immediately on the right.

If you join the Ring Road at a different point, follow the Central Area signs for **Queens**, until you reach the junction of Lensfield Road and Trumpington Street, then turn north up Trumpington Street, as above.

BY TRAIN:

There is a fast and frequent service from London King's Cross and London Liverpool Street through to Cambridge.

There are connections from Scotland and the North via Peterborough and regional services from Birmingham and the Midlands (East Anglia and North West).

For bus services from Cambridge Railway Station to the city centre look for the Citi 1, or Citi 3 services.

Queens' is a long walk from the railway station and it would be better to take a taxi which will take approximately 10 minutes.
